

STUDENT COUNCIL REPORT OCTOBER 2023

The student council had their first general meeting with management on Monday 9th of October.

Mr. Thompson was in attendance and the council discussed the results of our recent survey with him.

Although Mr. Thompson was very accommodating and anxious to respond to student concerns, he made it clear that health and safety would always be prioritised. In consequence, there is no prospect of the one-way system being changed or opening the toilets to all year groups. However, when given permission to leave class to go to the toilet, students should not go to their allocated toilet but to the nearest one.

On the issue of lunch time activities, we were assured that a large sum of money has been allocated recently for sports equipment.

Mr. Thompson did agree to the following:

- Alert Sodexo to the number of broken locks to toilet doors and paper holders.
- Investigate why the second gate is locked in the basketball court
- Investigate the replacement of nets for the basketball hoops
- Investigate the possibility of erecting a second water fountain and increasing the water pressure.

We are particularly happy to announce that from next Tuesday onwards, the courtyard will be opened on a trial basis for students who would rather sit and chat during lunch. We encourage students to take advantage of this facility because if the numbers are too small, Mr. Thompson will close it again.
