

Book Rental Scheme

2020-2021



St. Mary's CBS's Book Rental Scheme is open to all first year students. The Scheme provides books and most workbooks from 1st to 3rd Yr.

The scheme costs €200 (in 1st year) *The entire €200 must be paid by May 29th*

A week before 1st years commence school, parents are contacted to come in and collect books.

The books are covered and the students have the use of these books until 3rd year.

Cost of Book Rental over 3 years:	
1 st Yr €200	Closing date May 29 th 2020
2 nd Yr €100	Closing date May 29 th 2020
3 rd Yr	No charge

In 2nd year, additional texts are provided in Spanish/French/ English, Irish, Maths and SPHE.

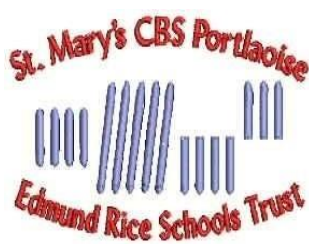
In 3rd year, Spanish and SPHE each require an additional text.

The following conditions apply:

- To qualify for admission to the Scheme, the entire €200 and the signed contract must be paid and submitted by Friday May 29th, at the latest. (to the office or online on our School App)
- No late applications will be accepted after this date from anyone who is currently enrolled for September 2020.
- The books supplied under the Scheme will remain at all times the property of the school. They may be new or used. They will be subject to inspection at any time by a member of the teaching staff.
- No student may write notes, underline print or deface their books or they will be charged for the full price of a new text. They may also be dismissed from the Scheme and required to supply their own books for the remainder of their time in school.
- Membership of the Scheme is at the discretion of the school Principal.
- Admission to the Scheme in the 2nd and 3rd years is conditional on the safe return of all books supplied in the previous year.
- All books supplied are covered in clear plastic. When they are returned at the end of their use, the parent must ensure they are covered or re-covered, if required.
- Purchase of school stationery and disposable materials, along with dictionaries, exam papers and calculators will remain the responsibility of parents. Art kits and Tech Graphics kits are not included. They must be purchased separately.
- Upon collection in August 2020, both the parent and the student must come in and sign for the books. Books are not given out without a signature and full payment.
- Once full payment is made, you will be contacted and asked to come in to the school to collect the books before your son starts school.
- You may post applications to the school if you wish.
