We are delighted to announce the 2019/20 season launch of the ADAPT All Ireland Linguistics Olympiad (AILO). AILO challenges secondary school students to test their minds against the world's toughest problems in logic, language and linguistics. Students must develop their own strategies for solving complex problems in unfamiliar languages — making AILO a fabulous way to hone problem-solving and lateral-thinking skills!

All second level students from schools in Ireland, both North and South, are eligible to participate. We have Junior (under 16) and Senior (aged 16 and over) categories. All registrants will be invited to attend one of our free problem-solving workshops all over the island in November / December 2019 which help students with strategy and introduce students to AILO puzzles ahead of taking the Preliminary Round in their own school. This year, the preliminary round will take place online. If your school needs to do the round on paper, get in touch with us.

Represent Ireland at the International Linguistics Olympiad

The top four students from the individual round at the AILO final will be selected to represent Ireland at the International Linguistics Olympiad (IOL 2020) from 20-24th July 2020 in Ventspils, Latvia. For more, see www.ioling.org.


Register Now to Receive Sample Puzzles

Registration closes on 24th January 2020, but it is very important to register ASAP to receive monthly sample puzzles, try a version of our new online test and to attend one of our free regional problem-solving workshops in November / December 2019. You can register your school at <https://ailo.adaptcentre.ie/>. The Preliminary Round will take place in your own school on 27th January 2020 (approx.). The PDF paper will be sent out to teachers for print under exam conditions. The answer booklet is online. All have a paper back-up. The top 100 students from the first round will qualify to compete in the national final in Dublin in March 2020.
