


- V-neck black pullover with school crest



Changing your options

- Those who have asked to change option subjects over the summer have had them changed
- Advice: Try out what you are given for a week or two. If it is definitely not what you
 want, the <u>student</u> should come to see myself or Mr Mulligan bringing a note from his
 parents/guardians, saying you wish him to be moved to another subject and giving a
 good reason why so. This is to prevent anyone moving randomly from 2 or 3 subjects
 while missing out on the courses which began on day one.
- We will always do our best to make that change.
- The only reason we may not be able to do so is if the subject you want is only on in one block and it happens to be on at the same time as another option choice which may only have one class and they're on at the same time then you will need to choose one.

Contacting the school

- If you want to speak to the Year Head, the School Counsellor of any of your son's teachers, you should ring the office 0578635041 and leave a message with Reception for the teacher/Year Head/Counsellor to ring you back and either speak on the phone or make an appointment to meet.
- If you wish your son to change a subject, it works quicker if you provide your son with a note saying what you want him to drop and what you wish him to take up and if it's possible we will do same. He should come to see either myself or Mr Mulligan and we will keep this note on file for future reference. We may also ring you as we are making the change if there is something we need to pass by you.



- RE is a core subject on the school curriculum and an integral part of the ethos of the school. All students are expected to participate in RE.
- In line with their legal rights, parents of students of a non-Christian Faith may request that their son not participate in RE / Services. The practice in such cases is that the student remains in the classroom under supervision. He is expected to study his own religion during this time. If a parent decides to withdraw a student, it is the parent's responsibility to organise supervision for the student while the programme is being delivered.
- Students who are not practicing Catholics but who do not practice another faith must fully participate in RE servicesclass/



- During the course of the next 5-6 years, you may have reason to ask for your son to be assessed for a specific learning difficulty.
- This is something we deal with regularly.
- If there is a query in your mind about your son's learning, please ring the office and ask for Ms Lynch, our AEN Coordinator, to give you a ring back.
- She will advise you, seek feedback from your son's teachers, or whatever she deems necessary based on your discussion.
